It is very evident, from the letter I received that local 4687, is violating the law by keeping in membership and as its Officers, men who do not come under our jurisdiction. In other words, their President, is said to own and operate four vehicles and the Secretary likewise. I am asking that you get in touch with a Mr. Woods, of the Central Body, whom I feel is trying to do his part in straightening out, this entire matter and he may be of some assistance to you while in that City.
