Description: In this segment, Ben Grauer gives concluding remarks and previews future guests.

[Ben Grauer:] This has been the Eleanor Roosevelt Program, recorded in Mrs. Roosevelt's living room at the Park Sheraton Hotel on the corner of fifty-fifth Street and seventh Avenue in New York City. Today, Mrs. Roosevelt's guest was Mrs. Michael Drury, freelance magazine writer, speaking of her series of articles titled Women and the New War. Tomorrow, let's see, tomorrow is Friday, and that means our guest is Major General Yalmar Rissa Larson uh General Rissa Larson is the president of the World Movement for World Federal Government and is himself a well-known explorer and military leader. On Monday, there's an interesting combination of gentlemen who have been invited by Mrs. Roosevelt to speak of their work. Phil Rizzuto, a famed Yankee short stop, will join Malcom Child, editor and writer, and businessman Ralph Lazarus to tell Mrs. Roosevelt and her listeners about the American Baseball Academy. The Academy was newly formed as an organization to fight the problem of juvenile delinquency.

It certainly will be interesting to get the varied points of view on this central theme from Mr. Rizzuto, Child, and Lazarus. Two members of the Air Force Nurses Corps uh are with Mrs. Roosevelt on Tuesday, Major Ruth Weidner who's Assistant Chief of that corps, and Captain Jonita Ruth Bonham. Captain Bonham is an Air Force nurse who has received the Distinguished Flying Cross for her bravery, her outstanding medical work in the air evacuation of the wounded from Korea. Next Wednesday we'll visit with the editor for the newly published volume, the Roosevelt Treasury, *Mr. James N. Rosenau*. On Thursday, Mrs. [Florence B.] George Hamlin Shaw will tell us of the work of the National Traveler's Aid Association and next Friday, a week from tomorrow, we'll visit with the Sunday Editor of the *New York Times*, Lester Merkel. Promises it's an interesting week next week and an exciting distinguished guest tomorrow in the presence of General Major Yalmar Rissa Larson, President of the World Movement for World Federal Government. Mrs. Roosevelt and Elliott Roosevelt will be with you tomorrow and every day, Monday through Friday, from 12:30-1:15 PM. 'Til tomorrow at the usual time then, this is Ben Grauer bidding you all good afternoon.
