AND, IF SO, WHETHER A MR ART STIENBURG IS RECOGNIZED BY YOUR
OFFICE AS THE OFFICIAL TEAMSTERS' REPRESENTATIVE IN THE SARNIA
AREA. MR STIENBURG IS DEMANDING FROM US AND OTHERS IN THE
LOCALITY THE EXCLUSIVE RIGHT TO FURNISH TRUCKING EQUIPMENT,
TOGETHER WITH DRIVER, ON INDUSTRIAL WORK AND THE EXCLUSIVE
RIGHT TO SCHEDULE THE EQUIPMENT AS TO WHEN IT IS NECESSARY
TO USE AND WHEN IT IS NECESSARY FOR IT NOT TO BE USED. TO
FORCE THE ISSUE TO A HEAD THIS MORNING MR STIENBURG BLOCKED
WITH TRUCKS THE ENTRANCES OF OUR JOB AT CANADIAN OIL COMPANY
AT FROMFIELD NEAR SARNIA PROHIBITING ENTRANCE OF ALL
EMPLOYEES EXCEPT SALARIED PERSONNEL. WE UNDERSTAND SAME
CONDITION PREVAILS AT THE IMPERIAL OIL COMPANY REFINERY AND
THE DOW CHEMICAL COMPANY PLANT. WE AND OTHERS IN THE ARE
ARE PERFECTLY AGREEABLE TO DISCUSS THE SUBJECT OF WAGES AND
WORKING CONDITIONS OF THE MEN BUT ARE ENTIRELY UNWILLING TO
CONSIDER THE UNPRECEDENTED DEMANDS PLACED UPON US REGARDING
CONTROL OF SOURCE AND USAGE OF TRUCKING EQUIPMENT. WE SHOULD
BE PLEASED TO HEAR FROM YOU REGARDING THIS MATTER AS
PROMPTLY AS CONVENIENTLY POSSIBLE
