In further reply to your letter of February 11, 1942, will advise that in the matter of charges brought by Milk Drivers and Dairy Employees Local #113 of Houston, Texas, against the Borden Milk Company, our appeal from refusal of Regional Director to issue a complaint has been sustained by the National Labor Relations Board and we are advised under date of September 11th, 1942, that the Board has decided to issue a complaint.

This action was taken after facts were presented on appeal and further investigation made by the Board and we believe the complaint when issued can be successfully prosecuted by the Board.
