Joint Council of Teamsters No. 7, of San Francisco and vicinity,  
is involved in a dispute with the Brewery Workers.

The Brewery Workers are petitioning the National Labor Relations  
Board to designate the breweries as a unit in collective bargain-  
ing. Our representatives are intervening with the claim that  
the proper bargaining unit does not embrace the whole brewery,  
but breaks down to the drivers, etc., as a separate classificat-  
ion.

The Teamsters of San Francisco and vicinity have been granted a  
hearing on their claim sometime during the second week of October.

In order to bolster and win their claim they will need copies of  
agreements signed with our locals throughout the country, cover-  
ing beer drivers.

Please forward a copy of any agreement you have covering beer driv-  
ers to Mr. M. O. Tobriner, Russ Building, San Francisco, California.

It is imperative that you get this matter in the mails as soon as  
possible.
