Dear Mr. Allan:

This will notify you that Local Union No. 258, General Drivers, Warehousemen & Helpers, P. O. Box No. 2931, Orlando, Florida, has been authorized by the Over-The-Road Drivers, who are employed by your Company at the Orlando Terminal, to represent them in collective bargaining.

At the present writing the drivers are in a somewhat confused state of mind, due to various remarks being made regarding their present runs being changed and the possibility of certain drivers rolling other drivers in the event the Union Agreement is put into effect etc. Therefore, we are requesting that the Company, as a spirit of cooperation, leave all runs in a status quo position until this matter can be properly adjusted between the Company and Union.

We are also, requesting that a conference be arranged in Orlando at your earliest convenience, within the next few days, for the purpose of working out an understanding regarding the matter of representation.
