Dear Sir and Brother:

The National Labor Relations Board, on November 4, 1946, issued an Intermediate Report in the case cited below, recommending that respondent, Basic Vegetable Products, Inc., Vacaville, California, cease and desist from recognizing Dehydration and Food Process Workers Local Union 474, A. F. of L. and Solano County Building and Construction Trades Council, A. F. of L., or any other labor organizations as the exclusive representative of any of its employees unless said employees have certified the union, cease and desist from giving effect to its contracts with Dehydration and Food Process Workers and Solano County Trades Council; and to withdraw and withhold all recognition of the unions (Local Union 474 and Construction Trades Council).
