If you have also any additional copies in your office pertaining to all jurisdiction, will you favor me by sending this book on jurisdiction.

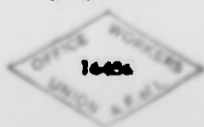

Dear Sir and Brothers:

I have your letter of March 31, 1943, in which you advised that drivers of a bus line picking up passengers between Green Bay, Appleton, Neenan-Wenasha, Manitowoc and Sheboygan have appealed to our local union at Sheboygan to allow them to become members of our organization. I also note that you have been requested by the representative of the Amalgamated Street Carmen's Union to lay off of these men.

I desire to say, John, that the jurisdiction over this work belongs to the Amalgamated Street Carmen's Union, and I would ask that you advise the local union to refrain from taking these men in. However, I believe you should assist them in becoming affiliated with the Street Carmen's Union.

If you believe it would be wise, I would suggest that you write direct to Mr. W. D. Mahon, President of the Amalgamated Street Carmen's Union, located at 260 East Vernor Highway, Detroit, Michigan. Tell him what the situation is and that you have been advised by me that these members come under the jurisdiction of his union. Ask him to send in an international representative to go over this matter with you and the local union involved.

Regarding the question of jurisdictional awards, I will make a notation here and have one of the girls get a copy of all the awards we have at the present time. However, I have never seen or known of any to be in booklet form.
