Received your letter of April 3, 1942, and have read it very carefully and am in full accord with everything you say.

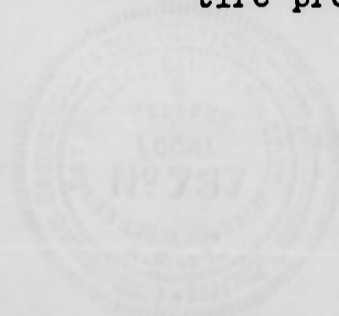
As an officer of this Local Union and also a member of the Joint Council Executive Board, I will do everything within my power to see that these orders are carried out to the letter.
