Description: In this short segment, Elliott Roosevelt reads a public service announcement from the civil service program about preparedness during an air raid.

[Elliott Roosevelt:] If your children are at school during an air raid, don't try to telephone or reach them. Teachers are trained to take care of them. Look around your home now. Pick the best shelter: probably in the cellar. Equip your shelter with flashlights, cots, first-aid kits, bottled water, canned food, firefighting equipment, shovels, and axes. This is a Civil Defense message. And now it's time to close the program and to remind you that you've been listening to the *Eleanor Roosevelt Program*, which comes to you each Monday through Friday at this same time, and this is Elliott Roosevelt speaking and wishing you all good day.
