Dear Mr. Evans:


We have studied the proposed by-laws of the above-mentioned union and submit the following suggestion:

Dear Sir and Brother:

The proposed By-Laws of your Local Union have been approved with the following correction:

In Article V, Section 1 (a) - delete the words "for two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00)" and substitute the following: "in an amount not less than the actual sum of money he will handle in a 12 month period."

The By-Laws are approved, however, should any conflict arise between these By-Laws or any provisions thereof and the International Constitution or any provision thereof, the International Constitution shall prevail regardless of the present approval.

This statement should be incorporated in your By-Laws when they are printed for distribution. Please forward three (3) copies to this office for our files.

Also, include at the end of the By-Laws the name of the International officer approving them and the date of approval.
