

February 7, 1969

A Special Meeting of the Trustees having been duly called, convened at the Gallery on February 7, 1969 at 10:00 a.m. Those present were: Mr. Hamilton, the President, Mrs. Chase and Messrs. Chapin, Finley, Gray and Thom. Mr. Walsh, the Treasurer, was also present.

After due discussion, Mr. Gray moved that the announced amendment to the By-laws to add the Chairman of the Women's Committee and the Chairman of the Friends of the Corcoran as ex officio members of the Board of Governors be withdrawn and reconsidered at the next meeting of the Board. After seconding, the motion was duly carried.

Mr. Hamilton spoke briefly about the qualifications desired for the members of the Board of Governors and for the Council. Mr. Chapin then discussed each person on the list attached and their capabilities. He said he plans to sound out each of these individuals with regard to the time they would have available to work and suggest they join the Council if their time is limited for the Board of Governors. Mr. Chapin requested and was granted flexibility in final appointments, depending on the reactions of the people approached, so that if their interest is not sufficiently strong or if they do not appear to be sympathetic to the objectives of the Corcoran, they will not be requested to join either organization. It was the sense of the Board that this flexibility should be granted. A few changes were made in both lists for various reasons, among them the need for more young people and a wider base for the Council. The lists were approved and thought excellent by all members of the Board. Mrs. Chase made the motion electing those persons to the Board of Governors and the Council whose names appear on the attached list, subject to the above qualifications, and authorizing Mr. Chapin to proceed with the organization of the Board and the Council. Upon seconding by Mr. Thom the motion was adopted.

Mr. Thom offered a resolution, which was duly seconded, regarding bank accounts: "Resolved, that the Riggs National Bank of Washington, D.C., is hereby designated a depository for the funds of this corporation and the said bank is hereby authorized and directed to pay checks and other orders for the payment of money drawn in the name of this corporation when signed by one of the following on all accounts in the name of The Corcoran Gallery of Art: President, Treasurer, Assistant Treasurer or Chairman of the Finance and Investment Committee." Upon motion this resolution

was duly adopted.

Mr. Chapin spoke about the problems between the Friends organization and the staff of the Gallery, and the necessity of bringing that organization into harmony with the Corcoran Gallery viewpoint. It is essential that the Gallery have reasonable controls over the activities and purchases of the Friends.

Mrs. Chase moved that the Trustees express their thanks to the staff, and particularly, Mr. Harithas, for the work and fine job done on the Biennial exhibition. Mr. Finley seconded the motion and all concurred.

The meeting adjourned at 11:15 a.m.
