Dear Sir and Brother:-

I herewith notify you, as Secretary of Local #654 that the Charter of Local #654 stands revoked this day, October nineteenth by order of the General Executive Board and it is understood that the members of Local #654 will be reorganized and that no officer now holding office in Local #654 can hold office in the newly formed union. It is also understood that in the event of reorganizing that only men who are hauling building material exclusively will be admitted to membership and all other men who are members of Local #654 at present and who are driving team and come under the jurisdiction of another local union must deposit their membership into the said local unions. I trust you will notify the membership of your local union, the action taken by the General Executive Board so there will be no misunderstanding.
