[Ben Grauer:] This has been the *Eleanor Roosevelt Program* recorded in Mrs. Roosevelt's living room at the Park Sheraton Hotel on the corner of Fifty-fifth Street and Seventh Avenue in New York City. Today Mrs. Roosevelt's guest was best-selling author James A. Michener, who, eh, inscribed or wrote the recently published *Return from Paradise*, a sequel to his bestseller of several years back *Tales of the South Pacific*. Taking a look at the guest list for the following days in this week we see that tomorrow, Tuesday, Mrs. Roosevelt invites to her microphone Lord [John Charles Wilmot, 1st Baron] Wilmot, a former British cabinet minister and a leading financial expert. Wednesday is the Fourth of July and aptly on this great national holiday, Mrs. Roosevelt is proud to present as her guest, General of the Army Omar N. Bradley, who, of course, is chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff and the author of the recently published book, *A Soldier's Story*. Following General Bradley on Wednesday, our guest on Thursday will be Henry E. Apt who is president of the Brand Names Foundation and will speak of the interesting work of his organization. Our week is completed with the visit on Friday with the president of the Forty Plus Club, Major Burton W. Elgin. The Forty Plus Club is an organization designed to help the man over forty who's looking for a position. Mrs. Roosevelt and Elliott Roosevelt will be with you again tomorrow, and our guest is Lord Wilmot, and every day, Monday through--Friday, from 12:30 through 1:15 pm.
