No harmony here, no Cooperation, very bad Propaganda; 18 Milk Drivers cases being tried to-day. Local broke, and all other Locals too I think.

Tom O'Brien wired me to-day about an Express hearing in New York on some one's case he is appealing. I did not answer him as I did not know exactly what to say. Only that I could not be there. Will write over

again as soon as I get something  
definite, although I can see I am a  
welcome as the smallpox here.

I am supposed to have got "plenty"  
for selling out the Milk Strike &  
the International deserted them when  
they had chance to win is common  
talk among the men who cant get back  
& who are trying to form the Co-Operative

Dairy. Will be glad to hear from you  
& do hope you are quite well with
