Chauffeurs in Chicago having trouble with Calvin at Checker Cab Co. barn. Heary advises however that they have the situation well in hand at present. Men employed there are standing firm with Local 727. Employers favor Chicago teamsters organization. Heary told Sheridan this morning to have Calvin kept out of there but Sheridan evidently could do nothing. Chicago teamsters have a board meeting to-day and Sheridan states he will request that Calvin leave 727 alone. Heary seems to think that the round up that is being carried on now in Chicago has quieted the situation at Checker Cab Co. at least temporarily. Sheridan told Heary that he wants to see you and ~~will~~ when you get back to office. Heary will call me if any serious charge comes up and I will let you know the result. Everything else all right here. I have ~~just~~ hear that Heary is in New York.
