In accordance with the International policy of amalgamation, I am reporting the following procedure covering the amalgamation of Local Union No. 638 of Mascoutah, Illinois, with Local No. 269 of Greenville, Illinois. A meeting of the membership of the Mascoutah Local was held on April 9, 1945, and voluntary action on the part of this membership approved the amalgamation of their Local Union into Local No. 269 of Greenville. The effective date of this amalgamation is April 9, 1945. There are some 33 members in this Local Union to be transferred into Local No. 269 of Greenville.
