In looking over the records today, I find where local union No. 637, Bottle Beer Drivers, of your city, have not paid per capita tax to this office since February, 1910. This leaves the local union practically eleven months in arrears for per capita stamps. They have not purchased a new charter, and you can readily see that they are really not a part of our organization.

I cannot understand this situation. This local union has been notified time and time again that it is in arrears. We have also notified you on several occasions and still nothing seems to be accomplished. I trust that you will make a careful investigation of this matter and the conditions of the local union immediately, and see to it that it pays all of its per capita tax and purchases its new charter in accordance with the law of our last convention.
