Dear Sir and Brother:

This will inform you that the Executive Board of Joint Council #16 approves the application for the issuance of a charter made by the New York City Uniformed Sanitation Men's Local, consisting of bona fide civil service employees employed as chauffeurs and helpers engaged in the collection and disposal of garbage for the City of New York.

This approval by the Joint Council Executive Board is given after ascertaining that Local 27 has no objections as it has a unit of private sanitation men employed by private concerns, and since the application we are approving applies solely to drivers and helpers engaged in garbage collection and disposal employed by the City of New York, and therefore will not infringe on the jurisdiction of Local 27's private sanitation unit.
